Youth (under 18yrs) - \$5

Small Sculpture Section - Market(unjudged)
- \$10 per exhibitor (no limit on entries)

- Multiple entries are encouraged.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.
- Applications submitted **without** an entry fee will not be considered.
- Entry will not guarantee display - the organisers will retain the right to exclude entries from the exhibit and competition.

LIGHTING:

Lighting your exhibit is vital as to how your work is viewed in the evening. Solar lighting is encouraged. Peripheral exhibition lighting will be set by the Site Manager/Electrician.

SALE OF ARTWORK

- All artworks sold (including items in the Small Sculpture Section) attract a 20% commission.
- Work not for sale (Judged Sections only) must be indicated on your entry (NFS=not for sale).

SITE ALLOCATION:

Where: Rotary Pioneer Park, Elm St, Tumut, offers a wide range of locations throughout the park.

Entry to the park via River St.

- Placement of works is the decision of the Committee President, with proposals for site-specific installations considered (eg elevated in the trees).
- See the website for images and further description.

INSTALLATION:

When: 8am to 10am 19th September 2015.

- Entrants should consider: ease of installation and removal, organising any assistance required to handle exhibit/s, realistic time frame for installation and removal of artwork, safety of viewers, weather conditions, including rain, high winds, etc.
- Artists are required to de-install their artworks on Sunday 20th September 2015 between 9am and 10:30am.

SECURITY, LIABILITY AND INSURANCE:

Artists exhibit at their own risk. Insurance for submitted works is the artist's responsibility.

- Tumut Regional Chamber of Commerce, organisers and sponsors of LANTERNS ON THE LAGOON will exercise care with artworks, but are not responsible for loss, damage or insurance of any work while in its custody or during the exhibition. Security staff will patrol the exhibition at night.

WORK HEALTH AND SAFETY:

- A PDF of the Risk Management Plan is available on the website, Facebook page or on the Tumut Regional Chamber of Commerce website
- The Artist is responsible for ensuring the installation remains safe at all times.
- All artworks will be assessed for safety during & after installation.

COPYRIGHT, PHOTOGRAPHS AND CATALOGUE:

- Artists retain the copyright and license but permit LANTERNS ON THE LAGOON 'Sculptures in the Park' to reproduce images of the artwork in the exhibition/ publicity, via all media
